At the U-CAN Day we will focus on three diagnosis groups – colorectal cancer, brain tumours and haematological cancers.

TWO MEETINGS IN ONE DAY

The first part of the meeting will discuss general aspects (legal, ethical etc.) of gaining access to data and material, together with a workshop session where questions from academic scientists on the data and material will be discussed.

The second part of the meeting will be an AIMday event – where specific questions from companies will be discussed in smaller parallel workshop groups with researchers having the relevant skills and knowledge.

Since 2010, U-CAN has been collecting data, tumour and blood samples and biomolecules, with the aim of covering 30% of Sweden's cancer patients.

The U-CAN biobank contains patient samples that are taken before, during and after cancer therapy together with comprehensive patient data and radiological images. The unique material can be used to develop methods to fine tune diagnoses and treatment regimes, to identify novel disease targets and biomarkers, and to analyse treatment efficacy and side-effect profiles.

U-CAN offers researchers and companies research collaborations covering longitudinal information and biobanked material.
