




Visitor Information

Travel information

Train

The nearest main-line train station is Sheffield, which is located in Sheffield city centre.

Local services also stop at Meadowhall.

Bus from Sheffield City Centre

Take the X1 Steel Link bus from the Arundel Gate 'Charles Street' stop to Attercliffe Road. Disembark just beyond the NCEFE, near Clay Street and opposite the Olympic Legacy Park.

The bus journey takes approximately 15 mins.

Tram from Sheffield City Centre

Take the Yellow Line tram from Fitzalan Square Ponds Forge to the 'Olympic Legacy Park' stop. The tram journey takes approximately 9 mins and the NCEFE is approximately 10 mins walk from the tram stop, via Old Hall Road.

Car

Parking

Canon Medical Arena, Worksop Rd, Sheffield S9 3TQ

There is a public, first-come-first-serve, car park at the new Canon Medical Arena on the Olympic Legacy Park. Turn left off the A6178 (Attercliffe Rd) onto Worksop Rd, continue and the car park is on your left. It is within 5 mins walk from the NCEFE. The postcode S9 3TQ may not yet be linked to the venue but **S9 3TN** is located on the opposite side of Worksop Rd.

Avoid a parking ticket:

This car park is due to have an ANPR parking system from October 2023. In this case, once you have parked, please visit the reception of the Advanced Wellbeing Research Centre (AWRC) and log your vehicle registration on the tablet there.

Then head across the A6178 (Attercliffe Common) to the NCEFE. Please see map below:
